

Cancelled because of Covid















Cancelled and postponed to 29-30 October with a shorter, 2 days, format


Cancelled again, keeping only the Careers in Science day to be organized at the end of October or in November



In 2020, one week - end of March

- 4 days scientific conferences (oral & poster sessions)
- Talks by 3rd yr PhDs + some invited foreign PhDs (8-10)
- Posters by 1st-2nd yr PhDs during lunch and coffee breaks
 - 1 day "Careers in Science" (wednesday):

Think about jobs, meet with industry and former ED's doctorates

- last afternoon (friday): a closing conference

On a timely topic, for a general audience (2-3 invited speakers)

Organization tasks:

But uncertainties for 2021 because of continuing COVID19...

- Prepare and send conference call for abstracts, receive abstracts and organize program, invite foreign students (or other ED students?).
- Invite, select, welcome and guide foreign PhD participants and/or other ED?
- Set conference web site, design conference posters and program booklet. Advertize the conference.
- "Careers in Science" day: Organize full day talks and discussions with speakers already working industry and academia (invite participants, manage the day). 2021?
- Logistics : order goodies, organize coffee breaks, organize teams for on site logistics (sessions, coffee breaks...)
- Coordination, between different organizing teams and between TE and PU.
- Set general conferences theme ("Exoplanets" in 2020), organize conferences and invite speakers

For 2021, re-use some work done for the cancelled 2019 CDD
